PRIMARY IDENTIFICATION

Bring One (original or certified)

- U.S. Birth Certificate (Must be issued by a county health department or the CDC Bureau of Vital Statistics)
- Valid U.S. Passport or Passport Card
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad
- Certificate of Naturalization
- Certificate of Citizenship
- Alien Registration Card (Green Card)
- Employment Authorization Document from USCIS
- Valid Passport and Proof of Legal Presence from USCIS
- **If your name is different than your primary document (listed above), you must also provide one of the following:**
- Original or certified marriage certificate(s) or court orders that show your name change(s) from birth name to present name if primary document doesn't reflect current name.

SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

Bring One (must display all 9 digits)

- Social Security Card
- W-2 Form (not handwritten)
- Paycheck/Stub
- SSA- 1099
- Any 1099 (not handwritten)

RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS (Must be a Florida Resident Address and Not a Post Office Box)

Bring Two

- Deed, mortgage, monthly mortgage statement or residential rental lease agreement
- Florida vehicle registration or title
- Utility bill; and/or Selective Service Card
- Any mail with name that is marked by any postal service (USPS, FedEx, UPS, etc.)
- Verifiable digital source that reflects name and address
- If you live with someone you can bring in one proof of address in the name of person you are living with and complete the Certification of Address Statement. Signature must be notarized if person you live with is not present. **(Cannot be used with CDL issuances)**
