

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

Effective Thursday, March 19th, 2020 all Alachua County Tax Collector Office lobby locations will be closed to the public until further notice. While our lobbies will be closed to the public, customers can continue to process transactions online at www.AlachuaCollector.com, through the mail, or by phone at 352-374-5236.

According to Tax Collector, John Power, “In light of the current public health situation regarding the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19), it’s in the best interest of the office to close to direct public contact until further advised.”

The Alachua County Tax Collector’s office serves over 40,000 customers per month (17,000 in-person), making it one of the largest customer-facing operations within the county. “By closing our office lobbies, it will help limit potential exposure of our staff and the public.” Power continues, “In anticipation of our lobbies being closed, we’ve worked to bolster our phone operations, mail, and on-line processing capabilities” Services that can be completed online or over the phone include, but are not limited to:-Vehicle Registration (Tag) Renewals-Limited Driver License Services, -Property Tax Payments, -Handicap Parking Placards, -Tourist Development Tax Payments, etc.

Customers wishing to reach the Tax Collector by phone should call 352-374-5236. In addition to closing office lobbies to the public, all in-person appointments for Tax, DHSMV, and other related services are canceled until further notice.
